Two by Two....We're Asking You!

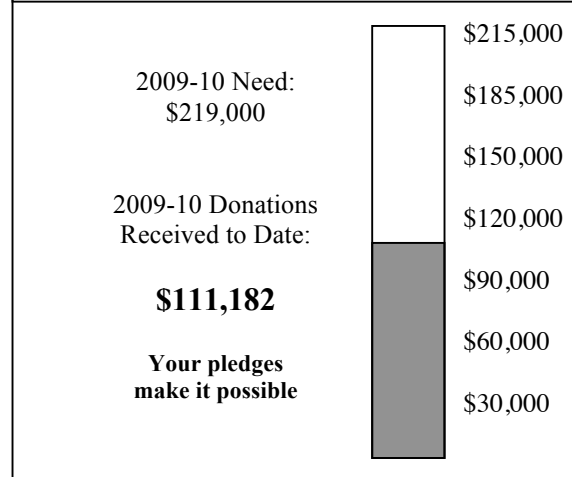
