

Frequently Asked Questions

Can my child shadow a class and/or can we observe classes?

At this time, we can arrange a meeting to view the site and have a conversation about the program, but observing actual classes is not a possibility due to small class sizes.

How do I apply?

The application process is kept up to date on the SunRidge website.

When will I know if my child is accepted in the program?

The lottery will provide numbered list of students interested in the HomeSchool program. As openings occur, students will be offered a place and the enrollment process begins.

If I am accepted in the program; what next?

Contact the main office at 824-2844 to find out about enrollment packet availability. Upon picking up enrollment packet; Theresa will indicate a date to return the completed packet. Finally, a meeting with the HomeSchool Teacher will be complete the paperwork process and assignments will be initiated.

What enrichment classes are offered?

This is dependent on students enrolled. The school year 2016/17 offered the following: K/1 class Mondays and Wednesdays from 9-1, Tuesdays - Spanish/Handwork for students enrolled in grades 1-5 from 9-11.

What happens at monthly Student Progress meetings?

These meetings are a time to review the work completed on the Assignment Form, collect non-returnable work samples for student file, and collect attendance forms. It is also a time to discuss what is working well, request support and/or materials for home use and to receive the next month's assignments.

How is attendance determined?

Attendance is determined by completing assignments and turning in representative work samples for student files.

Do you offer a stipend?

The HomeSchool program cannot offer stipends due to District policy. It does offer various Waldorf inspired curriculum to loan, some artistic supplies, lesson books and/or drawing paper and has a lending library
